Contract for the Procurement of a Service Provider for the Printing and Production of 2021 DOT Accreditation Stickers for Tourist Vehicles, Tourism Enterprises and Other Tourism-Related Enterprises (Lot No. 1)

This Contract for the Procurement of a Service Provider for the Printing/Production of 2021 DOT Accreditation Stickers for Tourist Vehicles, Tourism Enterprises and Other Tourism-Related Enterprises (Lot No. 1) (Agreement) is made this ______ 2021, in the City of Makati, by and among:

The **Department of Tourism (DOT)**, a government agency with principal office address at the DOT Building, No. 351 Sen. Gil Puyat Avenue, Makati City, Philippines, represented by its **ASSISTANT SECRETARY CHRISTOPHER V. MORALES**, and hereinafter referred to as the "PROCURING ENTITY";

and

TOPBEST PRINTING CORPORATION, a private entity duly organized and existing under the laws of the Philippines, with business address at 197 Ma. Clara St., Bet 9th & 10th Ave, Grace Park, Kalookan City, duly authorized and represented herein by its **SALES MANAGER, MS. SHIRLEY L. DIONISIO** and herein referred to as the "SUPPLIER";

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, under Republic Act No. 9593 or the Tourism Act of 2009, the PROCURING ENTITY is mandated to develop and enforce a comprehensive system of mandatory accreditation for Primary Tourism Enterprises, and voluntary accreditation for Secondary Tourism Enterprises, in accordance with prescribed guidelines and standards;

WHEREAS, as proof of DOT accreditation of Primary and Secondary Tourism Enterprises, the PROCURING ENTITY intends to provide such tourism enterprises with accreditation stickers;

WHEREAS, the PROCURING ENTITY is in need of a service provider for the printing and production of 2021 DOT Accreditation Stickers for Tourist Transport Vehicles, Tourism Enterprises and Other Tourism-Related Enterprises (Lot No. 1) with a contract duration of two (2) months effective from the receipt of the Notice to Proceed and has invited bids for procurement of the same;

WHEREAS, the SUPPLIER has submitted its bid for the procurement of service provider for the printing/production of 2021 DOT Accreditation stickers for Tourist Transport Vehicles, Tourism Enterprises and Other Tourism-Related Enterprises (Lot No. 1) in the amount of One Million Seven Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Five Philippine Pesos (PhP1,775,535.00), inclusive of applicable taxes ("Contract Price");

WHEREAS, after due evaluation of the bid of the SUPPLIER, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) of the PROCURING ENTITY, through BAC Resolution No. 2021-176, has declared the SUPPLIER to be the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB) and has recommended the award of the contract for the SUPPLIER;

NOW, THEREFORE, based on the foregoing, the Parties agree as follows:

 In this Agreement, words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.

- 2. The following documents as required by the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as integral part of this Agreement, *viz.*:
 - a. Philippine Bidding Documents (PBDs);
 - i. Schedule of Requirements;
 - ii. Technical Specifications or Terms of Reference;
 - iii. General and Special Conditions of Contract; and
 - iv. Supplemental or Bid Bulletins, if any
 - b. Winning bidder's bid, including the Eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted;
 - c. Bid form, including all the documents/statements contained in the Bidder's bidding envelopes, as annexes, and all other documents submitted (e.g., Bidder's response to request for clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid, if any, resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation:
 - d. Performance Security;
 - e. Notice of Award of Contract; and the Bidder's conforme thereto; and
 - f. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity concerned in the PBDs. Winning bidder agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract
- 3. In consideration for the sum of **One Million Seven Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Five Philippine Pesos (PhP1,775,535.00)**, inclusive of applicable taxes; or such other sums as may be ascertained, Topbest Printing Corporation, agrees to provide Printing/Production of 2021 DOT Accreditation Stickers for Tourist Vehicles, Tourism Enterprises and Other Tourism-Related Enterprises (Lot No. 1) in accordance with its Bid.
- 4. The Department of Tourism agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum in accordance with the terms of the Bidding.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT

1. Scope of Contract

This Contract shall include all such items, although not specifically mentioned, that can be reasonably inferred as being required for its completion as if such items were expressly mentioned herein. All the provisions of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 revised IRR, including the Generic Procurement Manual, and associated issuances, constitute the primary source for the terms and conditions of the Contract, and thus, applicable in contract implementation. Herein clauses shall serve as the secondary source for the terms and conditions of the Contract.

This is without prejudice to Sections 74.1 and 74.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 allowing the GPPB to amend the IRR, which shall be applied to all procurement activities, the advertisement, posting, or invitation of which were issued after the effectivity of the said amendment.

Additional requirements for the completion of this Contract shall be provided in the Special Conditions of Contract (SCC).

2. Advance Payment and Terms of Payment

- Advance payment of the contract amount is provided under Annex "D" of the revised 2016 IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 2.2. The Procuring Entity is allowed to determine the terms of payment on the partial or staggered delivery of the Goods procured, provided such partial payment shall correspond to the value of the goods delivered and accepted in accordance with prevailing accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The terms of payment are indicated in the SCC.

3. Performance Security

Within ten (10) calendar days from receipt of the Notice of Award by the Bidder from the Procuring Entity but in no case later than prior to the signing of the Contract by both parties, the successful Bidder shall furnish the performance security in any of the forms prescribed in Section 39 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

4. Inspection and Tests

The Procuring Entity or its representative shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the Goods to confirm their conformity to the Project specifications at no extra cost to the Procuring Entity in accordance with the Generic Procurement Manual. In addition to tests in the SCC, Section IV (Technical Specifications) shall specify what inspections and/or tests the Procuring Entity requires, and where they are to be conducted. The Procuring Entity shall notify the Supplier in writing, in a timely manner, of the identity of any representatives retained for these purposes.

All reasonable facilities and assistance for the inspection and testing of Goods, including access to drawings and production data, shall be provided by the Supplier to the authorized inspectors at no charge to the Procuring Entity.

5. Warranty

- 5.1. In order to assure that manufacturing defects shall be corrected by the Supplier, a warranty shall be required from the Supplier as provided under Section 62.1 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 5.2 The Procuring Entity shall promptly notify the Supplier in writing of any claims arising under this warranty. Upon receipt of such notice, the Supplier shall, repair or replace the defective Goods or parts thereof without cost to the Procuring Entity, pursuant to the Generic Procurement Manual.

6. Liability of the Supplier

The Supplier's liability under this Contract shall be as provided by the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

If the Supplier is a joint venture, all partners to the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable to the Procuring Entity.

	The Supplier shall provide such packaging of the Goods as is required to prevent their damage or deterioration during transit to their final destination, as indicated in this Contract. The packaging shall be sufficient to withstand, without limitation, rough handling during transit and exposure to extreme temperatures, salt and precipitation during transit, and open storage. Packaging case size and weights shall take into consideration, where appropriate, the remoteness of the Goods' final destination and the absence of heavy handling facilities at all points in transit.
	The packaging, marking, and documentation within and outside the packages shall comply strictly with such special requirements as shall be expressly provided for in the Contract, including additional requirements, if any, specified below, and in any subsequent instructions ordered by the Procuring Entity.
	The outer packaging must be clearly marked on at least four (4) sides as follows:
