



**SUPPLEMENTAL/BID BULLETIN NO. 1**  
**Procurement of Memorabilia for PRAISE Awards**  
**(DOT-BAC-IB 2020-009)**

This **Supplemental/Bid Bulletin No. 1** is issued to all prospective bidders to clarify, modify and/or amend items in the Bidding Documents as discussed and agreed during the Pre-Bid Conference held on 16 November 2020 for the above-mentioned project.

**I. On the Terms of Payment –**

The standard processing time is at least fifteen (15) working days upon receipt of the, fully delivery, final acceptance, and Statement of Account (SOA) from the awarded bidder.

Payment may be made through 1) LDDAP/ADA or direct deposit to the awarded bidder's Land Bank of the Philippines account (no Bank charges); or 2) Check payment.

**II. On the Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC) –**

Pursuant to Section 23.1 (a)(viii) of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 9184 (RA 9184) and the Bidding Documents. Section VIII. Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents, prospective bidders may submit a computation of the Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC) or a committed Line of Credit from a Universal or Commercial Bank.

Should the bidder opt to submit a NFCC, the computation of which must be equal to the approved budget for the contract (ABC). On the other hand, if the prospective bidder opts to submit a committed Line of Credit from a Universal or Commercial Bank, in lieu of the NFCC, the same must be at least equal to ten percent (10%) of the ABC.

**III. On the Statement of the Bidder's Single Largest Completed Contract similar to the contract to be bid –**

The Statement of the Bidder's Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) similar to the contract to be bid may either be a government or a private contract, and should have been completed within the last five (5) years. The value of the SLCC, adjusted to current prices using the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) consumer price indices, must be at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC.

Pursuant to Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) No. 16-2020 dated 16 September 2020, the SLCC shall contain the following information:

- a. Name of the completed contract with contract date, period and amount, which should correspond to the required percentage of the ABC to be bid. The value is adjusted to the current prices using the Philippine Statistics Authority consumer price indices, when necessary;
- b. The relevant period or delivery date when the said SLCC was completed (must be within the last 5 years);

- c. End user's acceptance or official receipt(s) or sales invoice issued for the contract, if completed; and
- d. Definition or description of the similar project or major categories of work.

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin No.1 shall form part of the Bidding Documents.
